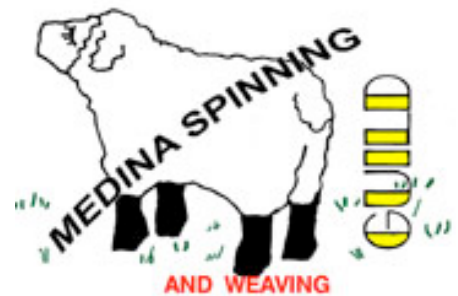

CARD WEAVING WORKSHOP

This will be an introduction to card or tablet weaving. Card weaving can produce bands of fabric for belts, shoulder straps, decorative edging for clothes and may other uses. Patterns can range for simple geometrics to images or words.

It can be done with very minimal equipment, a set of cards, a small shuttle and a method of maintaining tension. The simplest way of keeping tension is a back-strap loom. Other simple looms such as an inkle loom, frame loom or a small table loom can be used.
